



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 96
Series of 2020

**ADDITIONAL MITIGATION MEASURES TO BE IMPLEMENTED
IN THE CITY OF NAGA, CEBU TO COMBAT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19
IN VIEW OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-L
SERIES OF 2020 DATED MARCH 23, 2020**

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 on March 8, 2020 declaring the whole country under a State of Public Health Emergency to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of COVID-19, mitigate its effects and impacts to the community and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government and the community;

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Proclamation No. 929 was issued by the President declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines for a period of six (6) months, due to the increasing number of COVID-19 cases despite government interventions;

WHEREAS, in light of COVID-19 health crisis, the Cebu Provincial Government and this City Government issued executive orders detailing government protocols to complement and supplement national government protocols to combat the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, to further strengthen the mitigation measures being implemented in the Province of Cebu, the Provincial Governor issued Executive Order No. 5-L, Series of 2020 dated March 23, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KRISTINE VANESSA T. CHIONG, Mayor of the City of Naga, Cebu, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and law, do hereby adopt the provisions of Provincial Governor's Executive Order No. 5-L Series of 2020 dated March 23, 2020 and hereby Order the implementation of the following:

Section 1. In Hotels, Resorts and other accommodation facilities

- a. Group bookings composed of five (5) or more persons shall be prohibited.
- b. Group celebrations, parties, activities and other gatherings of any form are strictly prohibited.

For this purpose, five (5) or more persons gathered in an area shall be considered as gathering.

The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall primarily monitor implementation of this provision to be assisted by the team composed of CDRRMO, City of Naga PNP, CNTMA and concerned Barangay.

Section 2. In Island hopping and diving activities

Island hopping and diving activities shall no longer be allowed in the municipal waters.

The Philippine Coast Guard Naga Substation shall primarily monitor implementation of this provision to be assisted by the City Bantay Dagat

and the team composed of CDRRMO, City of Naga PNP, CNTMA and concerned Barangay.

Section 3. In Fast Food and Pizza chains

Dine-in shall no longer be allowed effective on March 25, 2020, Wednesday.

The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall primarily monitor implementation of take-out or drive-thru services, to be assisted by the team composed of CDRRMO, City of Naga PNP, CNTMA and concerned Barangay.

Section 4. In Restaurants, Eateries and Carenderias

Dine-in shall no longer be allowed effective on March 26, 2020, Thursday.

The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) shall primarily monitor implementation of take-out services in commercial establishments while the City Market Administrator shall monitor implementation of this provision in eateries and carenderias in the markets. They shall be assisted by the team composed of CDRRMO, City of Naga PNP, CNTMA and concerned Barangay.

Section 5. In Online classes

Online classes at all levels conducted in the City are ordered suspended until further notice.
