



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 92
Series of 2020

**ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES
TO BE OBSERVED IN THE CITY OF NAGA, CEBU
FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CEBU PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR
OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 5- E, F, G, I AND J**

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation Nos. 922 and 929 declaring the whole country under a State of Public Health Emergency and State of Calamity, respectively, amidst the threat posed by COVID-19;

WHEREAS, under Joint Resolution No. 11, Series of 2020 of the Inter Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease issued pursuant to Presidential Proclamation 922, guidelines have been set forth for LGUs outside of Metro Manila in imposing local community quarantined in their respective jurisdiction as the need arises;

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2020 Governor Gwendolyn F. Garcia issued Executive Order No. 5-E "*Prohibiting the Entry of Domestic Passengers Arriving in Cebu via Air Travel from Domestic Airports*", Executive Order No. 5-F "*Regulating the Entry of Domestic Passengers Arriving in All Seaports of the Province of Cebu*", and Executive Order No. 5-G "*Guidelines to be Followed by Local Chief Executives of Cities and Component Cities of the Province of Cebu*";

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, Governor Garcia further issued Executive Order No. 5-I "*Implementing an Immediate Ban on the Entry of Domestic Passengers from the Island of Negros*", and Executive Order No. 5-J "*Extending the Implementation of the Protocols for Quarantine to All Persons Coming From Any Foreign Country*";

NOW THEREFORE, I, KRISTINE VANESSA T. CHIONG, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law and to safeguard the health of the *Nagahanons* and prevent the potential spread of the virus, hereby adopt and implement the additional guidelines set forth by the Cebu Provincial Government in the City of Naga, Cebu and reiterate, as follows:

- Section 1.* A one meter social distancing and proper hygiene shall be strictly observed and implemented in all public and private offices, restaurants, internet cafés, karaoke, bars, banks, gyms, spas and all other commercial establishments within the City.
- Section 2.* All commercial establishments shall, at entrance gates, conduct body temperature check through the use of non-contact body thermometers/ scanners and install hand sanitizers, alcohols and other disinfectants. It shall also conduct regular and daily disinfection of its premises. In the event of non-compliance, such commercial establishment shall temporarily suspend its operations until it can comply with this provision.
- Section 3.* Public and private offices including churches shall conduct regular and daily disinfection of its premises.
- Section 4.* Public utility vehicles, including *trisikad*, tricycle and *habal-habal*, roads, sidewalks and other public places shall be subjected to regular disinfection by the City Government.
- Section 5.* Public gatherings with a crowd of more than twenty (20) people shall be prohibited. All scheduled gatherings and assemblies are hereby cancelled.

- Section 6.* Pools, recreation centers, and other communal activity centers in the City are hereby ordered close.
- Section 7.* Karaoke in all public places shall be prohibited.
- Section 8.* Cockpits and cockfighting activities of any form shall be prohibited.
- Section 9.* All restaurants, internet cafés, bars, service (food and drink) related establishments, spas, parlors shall close at 9:00PM, except pharmacies, 24-hour convenience stores and those rendering essential services.
- Section 10.* There shall be a citywide curfew from 10:00PM to 5:00AM, except for personnel charged with the delivery of goods and basic services and health personnel upon presentation of valid identification.
- Section 11.* All classes in all levels are suspended.
- Section 12.* Trucks carrying goods, sand and gravel and other necessities plying along the highways of the City and/ or entering the City of Naga's jurisdiction shall strictly observe the protocols required and implemented by the Cebu Provincial Government.
- Section 13.* The City Government shall implement the four day workweek subject to the Civil Service Commission guidelines. Private sectors are enjoined to adopt the policy and guidelines of Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) on the work schedule arrangement of their employees.
- Section 14.* The Punong Barangays shall strictly monitor compliance of this Executive Order in their respective barangays.
- Section 15.* The Emergency Operations Center shall be activated as the City Covid-19 Operations Center with the following emergency hotline:

- Section 17.* The City of Naga PNP shall give full support to the City relative to the implementation of this Order with particular emphasis to the implementation of the City-Wide Curfew.
- Section 18.* The City Health Office and the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) with the assistance of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) –Naga Cebu Fire Station and CNPS shall conduct inspection in all establishments to ensure compliance of this Order.
- Section 19.* All other orders, circulars and issuances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Order, are hereby repealed accordingly.
- Section 20.* Proclamations, declarations, directives, policies, guidelines, orders and all other issuances by the National Government and its agencies and Cebu Provincial Government, relevant to this jurisdiction, shall apply suppletorily.
- Section 21.* Let copies of this Order be furnished to all public and private offices, agencies, commercial establishments concerned, for their information and guidance.
- Section 22.* This Order shall take effect immediately.
