AN ORDINANCE OFFICIALLY NAMING THE STREETS IN BARANGAY ULING, CITY OF NAGA, CEBU AS FOLLOWS: 1. PUROK KAYMITO 2 TOWARDS PUROK KAYMITO 1 TO APOLINARIO U. BARIQUIT STREET; 2. PUROK KAYMITO I TOWARDS PUROK KAYMITO UPPER TO APOLONIO P. MENDEZ STREET; 3. ULING HIGHWAY JUNCTION TOWARDS BARANGAY ULING-BARANGAY TAGJAGUIMIT BOUNDARY TO PHILIPPINE NATIONAL OIL COMPANY OR PNOC STREET AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 13 (c) of Republic Act (R.A.) 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that the Sanggunians of component cities and municipalities may, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, rename within its territorial jurisdiction city roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges.

The Sangguniang Barangay of Uling passed Resolution No. 31, series of 2017 dated June 11, 2017 strongly endorsing to the City Council of the City of Naga, Cebu the naming of the identified streets as mentioned in the above title of this proposed ordinance.

The above-named personalities had greatly contributed to the development and progress of Barangay Uling as follows, APOLINARIO "POLINING" U. BARIQUIT was instrumental in the construction of a chapel in Sitio Bariquit Ventilation during his stint as Uling barangay captain in the late '60s; while APOLONIO P. MENDEZ was acknowledged as responsible for the establishment of a potable water supply project at Pelagio Spring in Purok Mahogany during his term as Uling village chief in the '70s. He also organized Barangay Brigade to ensure quick response during disasters and calamities.

Barangay Council members and residents also unanimously agreed in a public hearing to name the highway junction of Uling towards the boundary of Barangay Tagjaguimit as PNOC Street in view of the fact that PNOC, a state-run corporation, used to explore a coal-mine in the area.

Thus, the Sangguniang Panlungsod deemed it proper to recognize and give honor to individuals who, during their stints as public servants, have contributed to the socio-economic development and political landscape of the City of Naga, Cebu.

BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, Cebu, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the official naming of:

- a) APOLINARIO U. BARIQUIT STREET;
 - b) APOLONIO P. MENDEZ STREET; AND
 - c) PNOG STREET
- in Barangay Uling, City of Naga, Cebu.

SECTION 2. OFFICIAL NAME. Apolinario U. Bariquit Street, Apolonio P. Mendez Street and PNOG Street in Barangay Uling will be used as the official street names in all official transactions in the City of Naga, Cebu.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. For the sole purpose of this ordinance, the Office of the City Planning and Development Coordinator, the City Engineer's Office and other line agencies of this local government unit shall determine and assess the data, coverage and other technical descriptions of the abovementioned streets.

SECTION 4. FUNDS AND IMPLEMENTATION. The City Government of Naga, Cebu shall appropriate funds for the implementation of this Ordinance, which includes the mandatory putting up of signage for proper guidance and direction of pedestrians and riding public.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions unaffected shall remain valid and subsisting.


SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, orders, issuances, rules, regulations, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 7. COPIES FURNISHED CLAUSE. Let copies of this Ordinance be furnished to all offices concerned for their information, reference, guidance, and documentation.


SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval in accordance with law.
