.WHEREAS, it is the sentiment of this August Body to adopt the said Ordinance so as to establish an efficient coordination with the Cebu Provincial Social Welfare Office and other implementing agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Sangguniang Bayan of Naga, Cebu, on motion of Hon. Dolorita T. Nietes, to promulgate as it hereby promulgates the following Ordinance:

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2005-009**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-04 OF THE CEBU PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTITLED "PROVIDING FOR A COMPREHENSIVE CHILDREN AND FAMILY SUPPORT SYSTEM IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU"

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Naga, Cebu that:

- Section 1. Ordinance No. 2005-04 of the Cebu Provincial Government entitled "Providing for a Comprehensive Children and Family Support System in the Province of Cebu", otherwise known as the "Children's Code of Cebu Province" is hereby ADOPTED.
- Section 2. Creation of the Municipal Council for the Welfare of Children. There is hereby created the Municipal Council for the Welfare of Children, who shall ensure the effective implementation and enforcement of all policies, programs and projects relative Action Plan for the Welfare of Children, the composition of which are as follows:
  - a) The Municipal Mayor as Chairman of the Council.
  - b) The Chairperson of the Sangguniang Bayan Committee on Women, Children and Family Affairs.
  - c) The President of the Sangguniang Kabataan
  - d) The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer.
  - e) The Municipal Health Officer
  - f) The School Supervisor of DECS Naga District I, II and III.
  - g) A representative from the Municipal Trial Court.
  - h) A representative from the Naga PNP Station.
  - i) Two or more NGO representative to be appointed by the Municipal Mayor, with the endorsement from the Sangguniang Bayan
  - j) A child representative with a proven track record for being an advocate for the Rights of Child, to be appointed by the Municipal Mayor, with the endorsement from the Sangguniang Bayan.
  - k) President of the Association of the Barangay Captains.

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Section 3. Separability Clause. If any part or provision of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other part or provisions thereof which are not affected shall remain valid and shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

section 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

WHEREAS, this disturbing development needs to be addressed, hence the CLB exided to implement the CHILD'S RIGHTS PROTECTION UNIT Cebu Project on in the Cebu Province, one of which is the City of Naga;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, and on motion of Hon. Dominga P. Millena,

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, Cebu, to enact lively enacts the following Ordinance:

## LLI, CREATION OF CHILD'S RIGHTS PROTECTION UNIT

ATION 1. To protect the rights of a child against all forms of abuse and exploitation WHILD'S RIGHTS AND PROTECTION UNIT is hereby created and established in

TION 2. Definition of Terms- for the purpose of this ordinance the word CHILD is and as follows:

Under the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), child is defined as every human being below the age of 18 years.

Under Philippine Law, a child is one who is -

Below 18 years old or

18 years old and above but is incapable of protecting him/herself from abuse, neglect, cruelty and exploitation because of a mental or physical defect.

MION 3. The Rights of a Child – for guidance purposes to all implementers of this diance, the Rights of every Child enumerated under the United Nations Convention to Rights of the Child (UNCRC), shall be made as the basis for its implementation, to

TION 4. The Main Objectives of the CRPU of the City of Naga:

To decrease cases of child abuse and children in contact/conflict with the law.

To enhance the knowledge, skills and attitude of the implementers in assisting abused children as well as juveniles in contact/ conflict with the law in a most child-sensitive manners;

To advocate for the establishment of appropriate bodies that will respond to the unique needs of the children and promote accountability on duty bearers;

To raise the capacities of implementers to be able to uphold children's rights amidst involving issues and problems that confront and affect the realization of their basic rights.
