ORDINANCE NO. 2015-003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 (b) OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2010-002, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF BROILER RAISING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, Section 1 of City Ordinance No. 2010-002 which was approved on June 21, 2010 provides the Declaration of Policy that "The new, modern and sanity technology in broiler raising industry, particularly the TUNNEL VENTILATION POULTRY SYSTEM is required to all Broiler Raisers in this City, in accordance with the following guidelines:

(a) The new applicants for broiler raising operation shall adopt a new and modern technology in broiler raising, particularly the tunnel ventilation poultry system. No permit shall be granted to applicants if the standard specification will not be met.

(b) The existing establishments shall be given five (5) years after the approval of this Ordinance to upgrade their technology or modernize their equipments and adopt the standard specification."

WHEREAS, based on the time limit set, as provided under letter (b) aforesated, the Broiler Raisers are given until June 21, 2015, which is the fifth year after the approval of Ordinance No. 2010-002, to upgrade their technology into a tunnel ventilated poultry system;

WHEREAS, acting on the letter of appeal which the Broiler Raisers have submitted to the City Mayor and this August Body, it was commonly agreed that the deadline set to effect the Tunnel Ventilation Poultry System as mandated under Section 1 (b) of City Ordinance No. 2010-002 be amended in a manner that the deadline be extended to December 31, 2015 instead of June 21, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Othello M. Chiong, seconded by the rest of the Sanggunian Members present, it was RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Naga, Cebu to enact, as it is hereby enacted, the following :

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "**AMENDING SECTION 1 (b) OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2010-002**".

Section 2. **Section 1(b)** of City Ordinance No. 2010-002 which reads "The existing establishments shall be given five (5) years after the approval of this Ordinance to upgrade their technology or modernize their equipments and adopt the standard specification.", is hereby amended and shall be read as follows:

"The existing establishments shall be given until December 31, 2015 to upgrade their technology or modernize their equipments and adopt the standard specification"

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All previous Ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

Section 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code.


